GB 009.01 Declaration of Conflicts of Interests

GB 009.02 Minutes of the meeting of 24th October 2022

The minutes of the meeting of the 24th October 2022 were reviewed by the members.

GB 009.03 Matters arising and Correspondence

Decision: It was agreed to amend the Garda Vetting Policy as follows:

Page 7, Section 3.3 Disclosure of Criminal Convictions

(Sixth Bullet Point)

A staff member who works in the university and who has been convicted of any offence
relating to children and/or is subject to disciplinary action or sanction relating to children
must withdraw from working in any position or on any project which involves contact with
children / vulnerable adults / person under disability until the review panel can consider
the matter and decide on an appropriate course of action.

The Chair advised the meeting that she was in receipt of correspondence from the HEA regarding the Annual Governance Statement and this was being addressed by the ARC at its next meeting. The correspondence together with the draft reply will be circulated to the Governing Body for their approval at the December meeting.

GB 009.04 President's Report

GB 009.04.1 President's Update to Governing Body

The President congratulated all involved in the graduation ceremonies which had taken place in ATU Donegal and Sligo Campuses. She thanked the Governing Body members for their attendance and support at the ceremonies.

Dr Flynn provided an update on internal and external activities over recent months. She updated the meeting on her recent successful trip to the USA which included visits with Choose New Jersey economic development group and New Jersey City University, ATU Alumni event in Boston in the Irish Pastoral Centre, Boston and meetings with John Flaherty and Mark Morea at Cambridge University Centre.

A discussion took on an appropriate legal vehicle to accept philanthropy donations, this will require further discussion with the Finance Subcommittee and ATU Finance Team.

GB 009.05 Terms of Reference for Governing Body Subcommittees

GB 009.05.1 Strategic Development Subcommittee

The terms of reference for the Strategic Development Subcommittee were circulated for approval. Dr Flynn advised that the recent appointment of Dr Des Foley to the post of Strategic Planning Facilitator would assist in providing a monthly update to the Governing Body.

The Chair noted that the TOR can be further amended, if necessary, once the Strategic Planning Council and the Strategic Development Subcommittee are fully operational.

## **GB 009.08 Capital Projects**

HMcG joined the meeting and provided an update on the student building at the Galway City Campus.

Planning permission for the Student Building expires in mid-2023. Due to construction inflation the cost of completion of the student building continues to increase.

A budget of €14 was agreed by ATU Governing Body in September 2022.

Requests for an overview of all ATU Capital Projects was made by the Board. A risk register for the project was also requested together with a detailed presentation on the advantages and disadvantages of continuing/not continuing with the project.

It was agreed that the ARC could review the risks associated with both continuing and not proceeding with the student building. It was agreed that a review of all ATU Capital Projects would be carried out at the December meeting.

## GB 009.09 Integration of St Angela's College

SD joined the meeting and together with Dr Flynn provided an update on the integration of St Angela's college. A summary of key milestones was provided to the meeting highlighting significant progress in the integration process to date. A plan for the next steps in this process was also included with Q2 of 2023 identified as the provisional date when staff of St Angela's College would transfer to ATU and STACS would be established as the ninth campus of the ATU.
