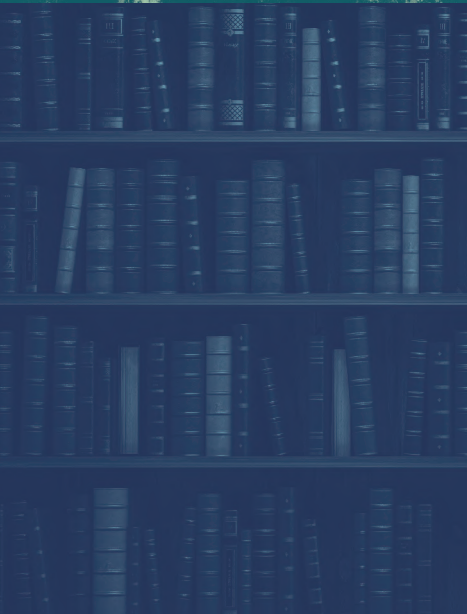

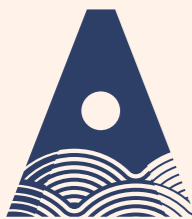

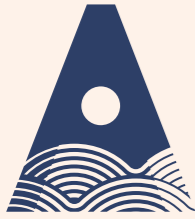

Atlantic Technological University (ATU) will soon offer a Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine and Surgery, and a Master of Pharmacy (MPharm) programme at the university.

Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine and Surgery

This 5-year, full time CAO undergraduate programme will primarily be based in the ATU Donegal Letterkenny campus, in conjunction with ATU's Mountbellew campus. 30 places will initially be offered with the aim of starting in September 2025. It is expected this programme will become available for selection during the CAO Change of Mind window in May-June 2025.

The ATU veterinary graduates will be work-ready, with a strong understanding of rural veterinary practice, ensuring that the veterinary industry can continue to meet the growing demands of Ireland's agricultural and farming sectors.

ATU will benefit from significant financial investment to develop a new state-of-the-art facility and the expansion of existing facilities, thus enabling ATU to contribute to the sustainability of the veterinary profession in Ireland.

Master of Pharmacy (MPharm)

ATU is currently in the process of seeking accreditation of a Master of Pharmacy (MPharm) programme from the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI). Subject to successfully completing the accreditation process, ATU will offer 36 places through the CAO on this 5-year programme at ATU Sligo, commencing in September 2025. It is the aim this programme will become available for selection during the CAO Change of Mind window in May-June 2025, subject to accreditation.

At the end of the programme, graduates will be entitled to register to practise as a pharmacist in Ireland in clinical settings supporting the health service and also in industry.

Significant investment in university facilities has been completed in the Sligo campus with the development of a €35million facility that includes state-of-the-art teaching and research spaces, science laboratories and a clean room.

There is no on-campus accommodation, however, there are options for digs, houses to rent on a shared basis, and in Letterkenny there are also a number of apartment complexes built specifically for the student market. Both campuses are quite central and most accommodation is within 10 minutes walk of each of the campuses.
