

National Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillator (ICD) Therapy Deactivation Guideline Development Group

Background

For patients who are approaching the end of their life, the issue of withdrawal (deactivation) of shock therapy in Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillators continues to be an issue. There are varied levels of service, pathways to access such services. There is also a lack of awareness amongst healthcare professionals, patients, carers and family around the issue.

Paul Nolan is chairing a multidisciplinary group, including key stakeholders, which has the aim of developing a National Guidance Document on Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillators Therapy Deactivation in patients who have been identified as nearing the end of their life. This work is being carried out under the governance of the HSE National Heart Programme. We commenced work in April 2024 and are meeting monthly to progress the work.

A funding application has been submitted to the ATU Unified Budget Submission for 2025. A request for €50,000 to help fund HEAL research activity has been requested. A further €25,000 has been requested to run an ATU Research Conference in 2025 inclusive of all research disciplines.
